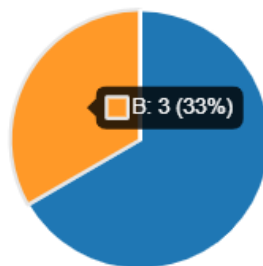

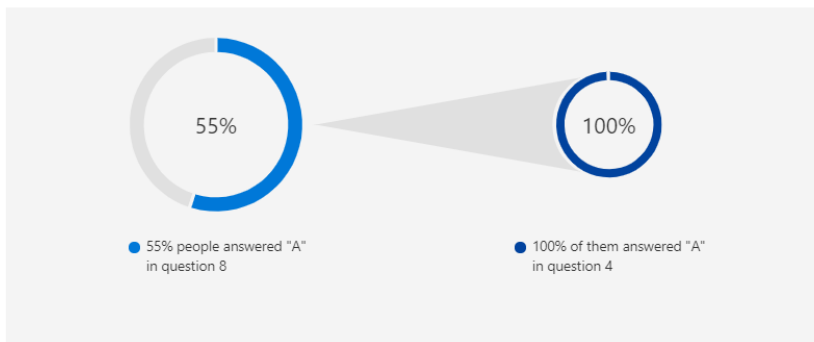

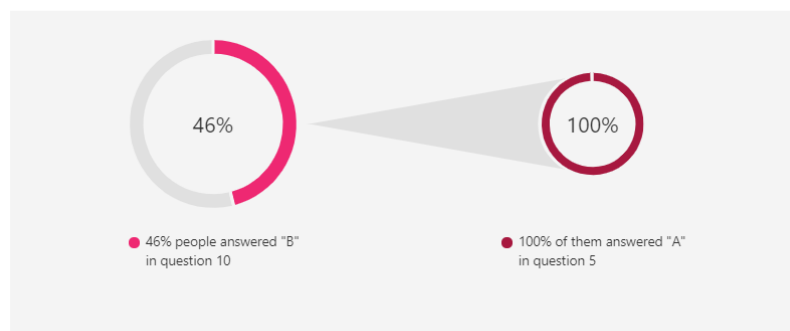


Trends from the data
